IRISH FOOD AND DRINK EXPORTS

Irish food and drink exports to **>180 countries** (2019)

2019 estimates on the value of food and drink exports from Ireland is **€13bn [+67% since 2010]**

**BEEF AND DAIRY**

Ireland is considered a **global leader** in dairy for food safety, sustainability and traceability, with produce reaching **124 countries** and exports valued at **€4.4 billion (2019)**, an 11% growth in value on 2018.

In 2019, the first full year of trading, Irish beef exports to China amounted to **12,000 tonnes**, valued at **€31m**.

Irish whiskey exports were valued at €722m in 2019, a **370%** increase since 2010. The US is the key market for Irish beverage exports, accounting for **40%** of the total.

**HORTICULTURE**

The strawberry is the most popular soft fruit in Ireland, with **57 growers**, **169 hectares** and **>1,000 employees**.

Potato production in Ireland is **12,000ha** with **600 growers** involved in commercial production. Ireland exports **€104m** of mushrooms.

Cereals and mushrooms make up the majority of Ireland's horticulture exports. Approx 15% of domestic production of Irish cereals is exported to Northern Ireland.

**SEAFOOD**

The value of Irish seafood exports is **€605m** in 2019 employs **>14,000** with **2,127** registered fishing vessels.

Salmon, mackerel and crab are the top 3 export species. Ireland is a recognised leader in organic aquaculture, with **95%** of Irish salmon farmed as organic.
